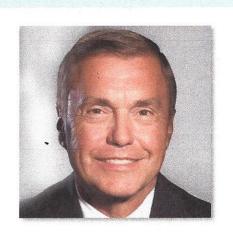
The phrase the "The future is now" is often attributed to
